CYBER CRIME

Anyone who is a victim of cyber crime should report it to the police on, www.actionfraud.police.uk

(A very scary recent two stage example of a SCAM designed to cause panic and that continued over five consecutive days:

A click on a link instantly closed the PC leaving alarm sirens blaring, all functions dead but with a written warning not to switch off and an invitation to ring "Windows". "Windows" remotely examined the PC and recommended a "Windows Certified Technician" to carry out repairs at a cost of £155.

"TalkTalk" phoned 24 hours later quoting the correct account number saying they had a discovered a connection fault that turned out to be "their" problem. They offered to pay £200 compensation via "Paypal" and generously "paid" £1200 in "error" only to demand a repayment of £1000. This was followed by numerous threats if they were not paid.)

It was all a scam and later confirmed by Windows, TalkTalk, the Bank, the Police and Action Fraud

If it happens to you switch off your PC. Put your phone down. The real TalkTalk does not phone its customers. Check with your provider. Notify your bank. Record all you can for Action Fraud.
