BT Launches BT CALL PROTECT to stop Nuisance Calls!

Actions you can take to stop getting nuisance calls.

1, **If you use** *BT Call Protect* **or the 1571 service**, you will automatically get 1572 soon.

2, (**Talk Talk** offers a similar blocking system for landlines, and **Vodafone** operates one for mobiles)

3, Register with the Telephone Preference Service (TPS)

It's illegal for a company to call such registered numbers. It's a free and easy to register service. You'll need your phone number, postcode and an email address to sign up on the T. P. S website. Or by texting TPS and email address to 85095.

4, Scams usually involve people being tricked into giving money. If you think a caller is trying to run a scam, you should <u>report it to Actionfraud</u>.
