## West Somerset House to reopen following refurbishment

Somerset Council's West Somerset House in Williton will soon be home to the library, Williton Registration Office a Customer Access Point and Health Visitors following a recent refurbishment.

West Somerset House, which has been closed since December, will reopen with the new services on Wednesday 25 June.

Cllr Federica Smith-Roberts Executive Member for Communities, Housing and Culture said: "By bringing the library, Customer Access Point and other services together under one roof, we're creating a hub where people can access vital services, get support, and connect with their community in a refreshed, modern environment.

"We want everyone to feel confident using digital services, and our Customer Access Points are designed to make that process straightforward and accessible."

Ahead of the move to West Somerset House, Williton Library will be closing on Monday 16 June, with the Health Visitors moving from the Children's Centre at the end of the week.

There will be no access to either Williton Library or the Customer Access Point until the reopening on 25 June.
